


Mayor's Summer Reading Club Partner Communications Toolkit

Program Overview

The Mayor's Summer Reading Club (MSRC), a program that promotes early literacy and vocabulary enrichment in young children, is truly a community collaboration. Each summer, close to 100 Atlanta-based community organizations and child care providers create literacy-rich programming for children aged birth through five and their families. These programs might involve arts and crafts, drama exercises, or other hands-on activities, but all are centered around the MSRC's book selections—a board book for children ages zero to two and a picture book for three- to five-year-olds. These books, many of which are created expressly for the MSRC, are joyful stories that often meaningfully mirror their readers' experiences as Atlanta kids. They're also carefully designed to cultivate language development and a love of reading for children and their caregivers.

This program is led by GEEARS: Georgia Early Education Alliance for Ready Students, in collaboration with the City of Atlanta, the Alliance Theatre, the Atlanta Speech School, and many other public-private partnerships with child-serving entities. This year, the MSRC has partnered with Young Authors Publishing, an Atlanta-based publisher with a global reach that amplifies the stories of young people of color.

The MSRC is made possible with generous funding from <u>PNC</u>, the <u>United Way of Greater Atlanta</u>, the <u>LuluMa Foundation</u>, and <u>WorldReader</u>.


Theme

Book Selections





Communication Strategies

General Tips

- Post about your event at least 2 weeks before the event, 1 week before the event, and each of the 5 days leading up to the event. If applicable, be sure to include a link to register for your event. Then, share photos and a recap of the event after it has ended.

- Tag @Mayor's Summer Reading Club on Facebook so that we can share your post.
- Tag partners in photos and in the text of your post.
- Use hashtags (#readbelieveATL and/or #MSRC) so that all partners can find and share each other's posts.
- Retweet/ repost content from Mayor's SummerReading Club's social media platforms.

Do:

- Engage with your audience in a positive way.
- Share content on a regular basis.
- Tag/mention partner accounts.
- Include a photo with every post.

Don't:

- Overflow your accounts with too much content at one time.
- Use too many hashtags.
- Use photos that are unrelated to your caption.
