

Filming Tips:

- Please keep in mind, the video does not have to be of professional quality. A cell phone or digital camera will be sufficient.
- Be mindful of your lighting. Your light should be balanced (not too bright and not too dark.)
- Steer clear of distracting backgrounds.
- Be sure your audio can be heard clearly.
- Be natural and conversational.
- Please shoot the video horizontally (landscape mode).

Video Content Guide:

- 1. Begin the video with a greeting and state your full name and title.
- 2. Acknowledge the early education workforce, express your gratitude for their service to children and families.
- 3. Offer words of encouragement and congratulations.
